

## Henry Schein Partners with International Veterinary Students Association to Donate Equipment to Typhoon-Damaged Veterinary School in the Philippines

### Donations Support Next Generation of Veterinarians

The College of Veterinary Medicine Central Mindanao University, which provides critical support to farmers in the surrounding area, has yet to fully rebuild. The donation is an initiative of Henry Schein Cares, the Company's global corporate social responsibility program. The IVSA will facilitate the donation's delivery to the school as part of its mission to improve the standard of veterinary education internationally through the exchange of ideas, knowledge, and culture.

"The rigors of a veterinary education are challenging under the best of circumstances, to say nothing of the obstacles these students have faced in the wake of this terrible storm," said Peter McCarthy, President, Henry Schein Global Animal Health Group.
