

## Temple University's Kornberg School Of Dentistry Launches The Henry Schein Digital Dentistry Program In Collaboration With Henry Schein

During the launch of Temple's program, 16 faculty members were trained to use the Planmeca PlanScan Scanner® and Planmeca PlanMill 40®. In addition, Dr. Amid Ismail, Dr. Hai Qing, D.D.S., PhD., F.A.C.P., Diplomate of the American Board of Prosthodontics, Assistant Professor, Temple University's Kornberg School of Dentistry, Department of Restorative Dentistry, and Dr. Aaron Segal, D.D.S., F.A.C.P., Associate Professor and Clinical Scholar, Temple University's Kornberg School of Dentistry, Department of Restorative Dentistry, were on hand to supervise student work, assist fellow faculty members, and celebrate the launch of the program. Dr. Robert Gottlander, Chief Marketing Officer for Henry Schein Inc.'s Global Dental Group, also attended to discuss Henry Schein's commitment to the education of future dental leaders.
