- Represents shares held by Lawrence O. Sneag, Stanley M. Bergman's wife or his sons as trustees of trusts for the benefit of immediate family members of Stanley M. Bergman or certain other persons, wherein Stanley M. Bergman is the grantor. Of the 10,100 shares attributed to Mr. Bergman, he disclaims beneficial ownership with respect to 5,100 shares held in trust by his sons for the benefit of the Greenidge family except to the extent of his pecuniary interest.
- Represents shares held directly by Stanley M. Bergman's sons.
